S.C. 2254, has been referred to the 20 undersigned Magistrate Judge pursuant to Title 28 U.S.C. §§ 636(b)(1)(A) and 636 (b)(1)(B) and 21 Local Magistrates' Rules MJR 3 and MJR 4. 22 Petitioner filed a proposed petition. Petitioner applies to proceed in forma pauperis. His 23 documents show an average income of between \$40.00 and \$46.00 dollars per month (Dkt. #3). 24 Further, the end of the month statement shows a spendable balance of \$7.78 (Dkt. # 3). Petitioner 25 can afford the \$5.00 filing fee in this case. The district court may permit indigent litigants to 26 proceed in forma pauperis upon completion of a proper affidavit of indigence. See 28 U.S.C. § 27 1915(a). However, the court has broad discretion in denying an application to proceed in forma 28 REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION Page - 1

pauperis. Weller v. Dickson, 314 F.2d 598 (9th Cir. 1963), cert. denied, 375 U.S. 845 (1963). Petitioner has the funds needed for full payment. Plaintiff has not shown that is unable to pay the full filing fee to proceed with his petition. Accordingly the court recommends the in forma pauperis status be **DENIED** and petitioner be given thirty days to pay the filing fee. Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1) and Rule 72(b) of the Federal rules of Civil Procedure, the parties shall have ten (10) days from service of this Report to file written objections. See also Fed. R. Civ. P. 6. Failure to file objections will result in a waiver of those objections for purposes of appeal. Thomas v. Arn, 474 U.S. 140 (1985). Accommodating the time limit imposed by Rule 72(b), the clerk is directed to set the matter for consideration on April 17, 2009, as noted in the caption. DATED this 16 day of May, 2009. /s/ J.
