ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

16 This case has been referred to United States Magistrate Judge Karen L. Strombom  
17 pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1) and Local MJR 3 and 4. Plaintiff has been granted leave to  
18 proceed *in forma pauperis*. Dkt. 4. On February 2, 2010, the court directed service of  
19 Plaintiff's First Amended Complaint. Dkt. 10. The waiver and return of service forms directed  
20 to Defendants Ryan Denzer, Michael Hines, Michael A. Flemming, Daniel Fitzpatrick, George  
21 Gilbert, and Ron Van Boening were all returned by the U.S. Marshal unexecuted and marked  
22 "not at provided address." Dkst. 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, and 17. On March 8, 2010, the court advised  
23 Plaintiff that before another attempt to complete service on these defendants could be made, he

1 must provide current addresses. Dkt. 18. Plaintiff was provided with additional summonses and  
2 marshal forms for that purpose. *Id.*, p. 2.

3 To date, Plaintiff has not provided current addresses for Defendants Ryan Denzer,  
4 Michael Hines, Michael A. Flemming, Daniel Fitzpatrick, George Gilbert, and Ron Van  
5 Boening. Accordingly, personal jurisdiction over these defendants does not exist and the court  
6 has no authority over them.

7  
8 Accordingly, it is **ORDERED**:

9 (1) Plaintiff shall show cause why he has not complied with the court's Order  
10 of March 8, 2010. He must provide the necessary addresses and forms or a sufficient  
11 explanation for his failure to do so **on or before April 16, 2010. Otherwise, the court  
shall recommend dismissal of this action for failure to prosecute.**

12 (2) The Clerk shall send copies of this Order to Plaintiff.
