3 All costs of service shall be advanced by the United States. The Clerk shall assemble the  
4 necessary documents to effect service.

5 (2) Response Required

6 Defendant shall have **thirty (30) days** within which to file an answer or motion  
7 permitted under Fed. R. Civ. P. 12 within **thirty (30) days** after service.

8 (3) Filing and Service by Parties, Generally

9 All original documents and papers submitted for consideration by the Court in this  
10 case, and a duplicate of all such papers, are to be filed with the Clerk of this Court. The  
11 originals and copies of all such papers shall indicate in the upper right-hand corner the  
12 name of the Magistrate Judge to whom the copies are to be delivered. The papers shall be  
13 accompanied by proof that such documents have been served upon counsel for the  
14 opposing party (or upon any party acting pro se). The proof shall show the day and manner  
15 of service and may be written acknowledgment of service, by certificate of a member of the  
16 bar of this Court, or by affidavit of the person who served the papers.

18 (4) Motions

19 Any request for Court action shall be set forth in a motion, properly filed and  
20 served, pursuant to the requirements of Local Rule CR 7. If a party fails to file and serve  
21 timely opposition to a motion, the Court may deem any opposition to be without merit.

23 (5) Direct Communications with District Judge or Magistrate Judge

24 No direct communication is to take place with the District Judge or Magistrate  
25 Judge with regard to this case. All relevant information and papers are to be directed to the  
26 Clerk.

1 (6) Clerk's Action

2 The Clerk is directed to send a copy of this Order and of the General Order issued  
3 by the Magistrate Judges to plaintiff and to defendant and defendant's counsel, if any.
