
**ORDER ADOPTING REPORT AND
RECOMMENDATION**

22 The Court, having reviewed the Report and Recommendation of Magistrate Judge Karen
23 L. Strombom, objections to the Report and Recommendation, [Dkt. # 85], and the remaining
24 record, does hereby find and **ORDER:**

- 25 (1) The Court adopts the Report and Recommendation.
- 26 (2) Defendants' Motion for Summary Judgment (ECF No. 18) is **GRANTED** as to
Defendants Clarke, Morgan, Ramsey, Brunson, Blakeman, Pemberton, and
Toohey. Plaintiff's federal claims against them are **DISMISSED WITH
PREJUDICE**; Plaintiff's state claims against them are **DISMISSED WITHOUT
PREJUDICE**.

- 1 (3) Defendants Motion for Summary Judgment (ECF No. 18) is **DENIED** on grounds
2 of Eleventh Amendment immunity as to Defendants Department of Corrections
3 and the State of Washington.
4 (4) Defendants' Motion for Summary Judgment (ECF No. 18) is **DENIED** as to
5 Defendants Nicholas and Annis (as to claims that they failed to timely assist or
6 aid Plaintiff during the attack).
7 (5) The Clerk is directed to send copies of this Order to Plaintiff, counsel for
8 Defendants and to the Hon. Karen L. Strombom.
