After the Court issues the order for EAJA fees and expenses, the Commissioner will 1 consider the matter of Plaintiff's assignment of EAJA fees and expenses to Plaintiff's 2 3 attorney. Pursuant to Astrue v. Ratliff, the ability to honor the assignment will depend on whether the EAJA fees and expenses are subject to any offset allowed under the Treasury 4 5 Offset Program. The Commissioner agrees to contact the Department of Treasury after the order for EAJA fees and expenses is entered to determine whether the EAJA fees and 6 7 expenses are subject to any offset.
