ald be disregarded for purposes of diversity jurisdiction.	
Bayer also points out, persuasively, that the MDL Judge handling the YAZ cases is i	n
handling all manner of pretrial Motions, including Motions to Remand, and resolving c	laim
raudulent joinder. See Dkt. 12, at Exs E-J.
