ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO AMEND
COMPLAINT

20 Before the Court is Plaintiff's Motion for Leave to Amend Complaint. ECF No. 66.

21 Plaintiff seeks leave to amend his Amended Complaint (ECF No. 44) to add Eric Jackson as a
22 Defendant. Plaintiff states that he has learned through discovery that Mr. Jackson, a correctional
23 specialist, was involved with Devon Schrum in the decision to deny the WCC recommendation
24 to promote Plaintiff to a medium custody facility. Plaintiff alleges that this act was retaliatory
25 and that he was deprived of due process when he was sent to WSP. ECF No. 44, pp. 7-8.

ORDER- 1

1 Defendants have filed no opposition to Plaintiff's motion for leave to amend his amended
2 complaint.

3 Accordingly, it is **ORDERED**:

4 (1) Plaintiff's motion for leave to amend (ECF No. 66) is **GRANTED**; the
5 **amendment shall be limited to the addition of Devon Shrum as stated in Plaintiff's motion.**
6 Plaintiff may submit his First Amended Complaint **on or before March 16, 2012.** Plaintiff shall
7 also submit a service copy and service address for service of the First Amended Complaint on
8 Devon Shrum.

10 (2) The Clerk shall send a copy of this Order to Plaintiff and counsel for Defendants.
