19 This matter comes before the Court on the Report and Recommendation of U.S.  
20 Magistrate Judge Karen L. Strombom. Dkt. 106. The Magistrate Judge recommends that  
21 Defendants' motion for summary judgment be granted and Plaintiff's federal claims against  
22 Defendants Carolee Roop, Michael Estes, Kristi Entrop, Crispin Juguilon, Lawrence Adamire,  
23 Ron Fraker, Shawn Walker, Kurt Grubb, Daniel DeLeon, John Palmer, Jason Romero, and  
24 Donald Taber be dismissed with prejudice, and all state law claims against these Defendants be  
25 dismissed without prejudice. Dkt. 106 p. 2, 58. The Court need only make a de novo

1 determination of the portions of Magistrate Judge Strombom's Report and Recommendation to  
2 which Plaintiff makes objections. 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1). Plaintiff has not filed any objection to  
3 the Report and Recommendation.

4 The Court, having reviewed the Report and Recommendation of Magistrate Judge Karen  
5 L. Strombom, and the remaining record, does hereby find and **ORDER**:

- 6 1) The Court adopts the Report and Recommendation.
- 7 2) The motion for summary judgment of Defendants Carolee Roop, Michael  
8 Estes, Kristi Entrop, Crispin Juguilon, Lawrence Adamire, Ron Fraker,  
9 Shawn Walker, Kurt Grubb, Daniel DeLeon, John Palmer, Jason Romero,  
10 and Donald Taber (Dkt. 89) is **GRANTED** and Plaintiff's federal claims  
11 against these Defendants are **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**, and  
12 state claims against them are dismissed without prejudice.
- 13 3) The Clerk is directed to send copies of this Order to Plaintiff and to the  
14 Hon. Karen L. Strombom.
