15	This matter comes before the Court on Plaintiff Amrish Rajagopalan's ("Rajagopalan") motion to lift stay (Dkt 49). On March 6, 2012, the Court denied Defendant NoteWorld, LLC's ("NoteWorld") motion to dismiss and compel arbitration. Dkt. 33. On March 19, 2012, NoteWorld filed

19	a notice of appeal of that order. Dkt. 34. On June 11, 2012, the Court stayed this action	
20	pending determination of NoteWorld's appeal. Dkt. 48.	
	On August 23, 2012, Rajagopalan filed a motion to lift the stay based on newly	
21	discovered evidence. Dkt. 49. On August 31, 2012, NoteWorld responded. Dkt. 51. On

1	September 7, 2012, Rajagopalan replied. Dkt. 52. On October 10, 2012, Note World	
2	filed notice of additional authority. Dkt. 53.	
3	In the Ninth Circuit, entry of a stay pending an appeal of an order to deny a motion	
4	to compel arbitration is discretionary. See Britton v. Co-op Banking Group, 916 F.2d	
5	1405, 1412 (9th Cir. 1990).	
6	The Court has considered the parties' briefs and Rajagopalan's additional evidence	
7	and finds that a stay should and will remain in effect. Therefore, the Court DENIES	
8	Rajagopalan's motion to lift the stay (Dkt. 49).	
9	IT IS SO ORDERED.
