Therefore, Plaintiff's response to the 15 motion was due on November 12, 2012. On November 16, 2012, Plaintiff filed a motion for 16 leave to file his reply brief past the deadline. ECF No. 41. He also filed a Declaration, which 17 appears to be his response in opposition to Defendants' motion for summary judgment. ECF No. 18 42. Plaintiff states that he attempted to mail his response in a timely manner, but it was returned 19 to him by prison authorities for failure to attach a "postage transfer" form. *Id*. 20 21 Accordingly, it is **ORDERED**: 22 Plaintiff's motion for leave to file reply (ECF No. 41) is **GRANTED.** The Court (1) 23 will consider the Declaration (ECF No. 42) as having been timely filed. 24 25 26
