ORDER DENYING MOTIONS FOR
EXTENSIONS OF TIME

19 Plaintiff has filed two motions for extension of time. ECF Nos. 121 and 122. In the
20 first motion, Plaintiff seeks an extension of time to file an objection to the Court's May 7,
21 2012 Order denying his motion to compel. ECF No. 112 (Order denying Plaintiff's Motion to
22 Compel (ECF No. 74) and granting Plaintiff's Motion for Extension of Time to File Reply
23 (ECF No. 90)). In the second motion, Plaintiff seeks an extension of time to file a reply to
24 Defendants' response to his Motion for Temporary Restraining Order. ECF No. 122.

1 However, Plaintiff's motions for temporary injunctive relief (ECF Nos. 10 and 19) and his
2 motion for an extension of time (ECF No. 50) were denied on March 2, 2012. ECF No. 64.


3 Plaintiff claims that he needs these extensions because he has not yet received a ruling
4 on his request that the Court provide him notice of the ECF numbers assigned to all
5 documents filed in this case and paging information for attachments associated with all
6 electronic entries. *See, e.g.*, ECF No. 121, at 1. However, that motion was denied on
7 December 8, 2011. ECF No. 29.

8 Accordingly, it is **ORDERED**:

9 (1) Plaintiff's motions for extensions of time (ECF Nos. 121 and 122) are
10 **DENIED as moot.**

11 (2) The Clerk shall send a copy of this Order to Plaintiff and counsel for
12 Defendants.
