ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFF'S
MOTION TO AMEND COMPLAINT

19 Before the Court is Plaintiff's Motion to Amend Complaint. ECF No. 45 (with
20 proposed Amended Complaint attached at 45-1 and 45-2). Defendants do not object to
21 Plaintiff's motion to amend. ECF No. 51. Accordingly, Plaintiff shall be granted leave to
22 amend his complaint as proposed. Plaintiff is reminded that he must serve all Defendants who
23 are named in his amended complaint who have not yet been served with his original complaint.
24 See Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(m). Pursuant to Rule 4(m), Plaintiff must serve copies of the Summons
25 and Amended Complaint upon each of the named Defendants within 120 days of this Order.

1 Accordingly, it is **ORDERED**:

2 (1) Plaintiff's Motion to Amend (ECF No. 45) is **GRANTED**.

3 (2) The Clerk is directed to docket Plaintiff's proposed Amended Complaint (ECF
4 No. 45-1 and 45-2 as a separate docket entry and to send a copy of this Order to Plaintiff and
5 counsel for Defendants.
