The Washington State Department of Financial Institutions was not a party to the Confidentiality Agreement between plaintiffs and FDIC-R. The Department was not informed that its confidential bank examination reports were to be disclosed, without notice to or the consent of the Director, in violation of RCW 30.04.075. The Department was not served with the Motion to Unseal. The Department has made a prima facie case that granting the Motion to Unseal would adversely impact the Director's obligation to preserve bank examination confidentiality under RCW 30.04.075, and that it should be allowed additional time to consider intervention under Fed. R. Civ. P. 24(a)(2) or other resolution satisfying its interests in protecting its Reports of Examination. This Court therefore finds good cause exists to grant the requested relief.
