15	This matter comes before the Court on Defendants' notice of removal (Dkt. 1).	
16	On August 2, 2012, Plaintiff filed a petition for appointment of custodial receiver	
17	in the Kitsap County Superior Court for the State of Washington. Dkt. 1–5. Plaintiff	
18	alleges that Defendant is in default of a Deed of Trust and requests that the state court	
19	appoint a receiver to take possession of Defendant pursuant to RCW 7.60.015. <i>Id</i> .	
20	If at any time before final judgment it appears that the district court lacks subject	
21	matter jurisdiction, the case shall be remanded. 28 U.S.C. § 1447(c).

1	The Court does not have jurisdiction over this receivership action. There is no	
2	federal subject matter jurisdiction because the action is brought pursuant to a state statute.	
3	There is no diversity jurisdiction because both parties are citizens of Washington.	
4	Therefore, the Court REMANDS this action to state court.	
5	IT IS SO ORDERED.
