REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

12 This matter has been referred to the undersigned Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C.
13 § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule MJR 4(a)(4) and as authorized by Mathews, Secretary of H.E.W.
14 v. Weber, 423 U.S. 261 (1976). This matter is before the Court on the stipulated motion for
15 remand. (ECF 17). After reviewing the parties' stipulated motion and the remaining record, the
16 undersigned recommends that the Court grant the parties' motion, and remand this matter to the
17 Commissioner for further proceedings.
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19 This Court recommends that on remand, the Administrative Law Judge shall reassess the
20 severity of the claimant's impairments, including her fibromyalgia per SSR 12-2p; give further
21 consideration to the medical opinions of record, including the opinions of Dr. Supplitt and
22 Wolfe, and articulate what weight is given to each; reevaluate the claimant's residual functional
23 capacity assessment; reassess the claimant's credibility as set forth in SSR 96-7p, and reassess
24 steps four and five with the assistance of a vocational expert, if necessary.
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
