Richard Creatura. The Court's authority for the referral is 28 U.S.C. § 17 636(b)(1)(A) and (B), and Magistrate Judge Rules MJR3 and MJR4. 18 Plaintiff's action for injunctive relief survived defendant's motion to dismiss (ECF No. 19 40). The case was remanded to this Court for further proceedings on September 12, 2013. 20 Defendants have failed to file a timely answer to plaintiff's complaint. Plaintiff has the burden 21 of moving the case forward by bringing a motion for default judgment pursuant to Rule 55(b)(2). 22 Because plaintiff has the burden to prosecute his action, the Court orders plaintiff to 23 move the case forward or show cause why this action should not be dismissed for failure to 24
