Richard Creatura. The Court's authority for the referral is 28 U.S.C. § 18 636(b)(1)(A) and (B), and Magistrate Judge Rules MJR3 and MJR4. 19 Plaintiff has sent two letters to the Court (ECF No. 20 and 23). Plaintiff alleges that 20 unnamed prison personnel retaliated against him for filing this action (ECF No. 20). Plaintiff also 21 asks the Court for time to try and reach a settlement with defendants' counsel (ECF No 23). 22 The Court does not conduct business by letter. If plaintiff wishes the Court to take any 23 action, plaintiff will have to file a motion that is properly noted and served on all parties who 24
