16	This matter has been referred to Magistrate Judge J. Richard Creatura pursuant to 28	
17		
18	U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Magistrates Rule MJR 4(a)(4), and as authorized by <i>Mathews</i> ,	
19	Secretary of H.E.W. v. Weber, 423 U.S. 261 (1976). This matter is before the Court on	
20	defendant's stipulated motion to remand the matter to the administration for further	
21	consideration. (ECF No. 22.)	
22	After reviewing defendant's stipulated motion and the relevant record, the undersigned	
22	recommends that the Court grant defendant's motion, and reverse and remand this matter to the	
23	Acting Commissioner pursuant to sentence four	of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g).

1	On remand, based on the parties' stipulation, this Court recommends that a de novo	
2	hearing be held before an administrative law judge (ALJ), and plaintiff may raise any issue. The	
3	ALJ will perform the sequential evaluation process for the period of January 31, 2004 through	
4	December 31, 2006 without a presumption of continuing nondisability, pursuant to <i>Chavez v</i> .	
5	Bowen, 844 F.2d 691 (9th Cir. 1988). The ALJ will obtain services of a medical expert; reassess	
6	plaintiff's residual functional capacity; and obtain vocational expert testimony, using the new	
7	residual functional capacity assessment.	
8	Following proper presentation, this Court will consider plaintiff's application for costs	
9	and attorney's fees pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2412(d) and 42 U.S.C. § 406(b).	
10	JUDGMENT should be entered for Plaintiff, and this case should be closed.	
11	Given the facts and the parties' stipulation, the Court recommends that the District Judge	
12	immediately approve this Report and Recommendation and order that the case be REVERSED	
13	and REMANDED pursuant to sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g).
