

The Court recommends that this action be dismissed without prejudice. Plaintiff has not paid the filing fee or moved for in forma pauperis status. See Funtanilla v. Down, 131 Fed. Appx, 536, 537 (9th Cir. 2005)(dismissal for failure to pay filing fee). Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1) and Fed. R. Civ. P. 72(b), the parties shall have fourteen (14) days from service of this Report to file written objections. See also Fed. R. Civ. P. 6. Failure to file objections will result in a waiver of those objections for purposes of de novo review by the district judge. See 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C). Accommodating the time limit imposed by Fed. R. Civ. P. 72(b), the clerk is directed to set the matter for consideration on November 29, 2013, as noted in the caption. Dated this 5th day of November, 2013. J.
