times. Dkt. 4. Arreola did not respond, which the Court considers an admission that the motion has merit. Local Rule 7(b)(2). On June 6, 2014, Smith replied. Dkt. 7. With regard to the merits of Smith's motion, the Court agrees with Smith as to both amending the caption and dismissing the complaint. Arreola has failed to show that he has exhausted his claims or that the defamation claim is not barred. Therefore, the Court **GRANTS** Smith's motion.
