5	(1) The R&R is <b>ADOPTED</b> ;		
6	(2) Williams's motion to proceed <i>in forma pauperis</i> is <b>DENIED</b> ;		
7	(3) Williams's complaint is <b>DISMISSED</b> ; and		
8	(4) The Clerk shall close this case.
