Richard Creatura pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(A) and (B), and local 18 Magistrate Judge Rules MJR1, MJR3 and MJR4. 19 Currently before the Court is plaintiff's motion for additional time to file a response to 20 defendants' motion for summary judgment (Dkt. 27). Defendants' motion for summary 21 judgment was noted for consideration on January 23, 2015 (Dkt. 23). Defendants have 22 responded to plaintiff's motion and do not oppose a sixty-day extension to allow plaintiff time to 23 24

1	file a response to their motion (Dkt. 28). Accordingly, the Court need not wait for the February
2	6, 2015 noting date to decide this motion.
3	The Court grants plaintiff's motion for additional time to file a response. The Court
4	orders the Clerk's Office to re-note Defendants' motion for summary judgment (Dkt. 23), for
5	April 10, 2015. Plaintiff's response is due on or before March 27, 2015. Defendants' reply must
6	be filed on or before April 10, 2015.
