Richard Creatura pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(A) and (B), and local 17 Magistrate Judge Rules MJR1, MJR3 and MJR4. 18 The Court granted plaintiff in forma pauperis status and ordered the clerk's office to 19 attempt to serve the action by mail (Dkt. 4 and 6). Mail from the clerk's office, sent to defendant 20 Stewart, has been returned with a notation that defendant Stewart is not at the address supplied 21 by plaintiff (Dkt. 7). 22 The Court orders that plaintiff provide an address where the Court can serve defendant 23 Stewart. Plaintiff must provide an address for defendant Stewart on or before May 1, 2015. 24
