Richard Creatura. The authority for the referral is 28 U.S.C. § 636 (b) (1) 17 (A) and (B), and local Magistrate Judge Rules MJR3 and MJR4. Petitioner seeks relief from a 18 state conviction, thus, the petition is filed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254. 19 Respondent asks for an extension until June 18, 2015 to file an answer to petitioner's 20 habeas corpus petition (Dkt. 19). Counsel for respondent explains that the habeas petition 21 contains a large number of claims, he had an unusually high number of deadlines recently and 22 has not had sufficient time to complete the answer (id.). Petitioner does not oppose respondent's 23 request for an extension (Dkt. 21).
