14 This is a federal habeas action filed under 28 U.S.C. § 2254. *See* Dkt. 1. Petitioner filed
15 his Petition through counsel, Jeffery Ellis. Petitioner moves the Court to appoint Mr. Ellis to
16 represent him in this matter. Dkt. 2. The Motion for Appointment of Counsel states

17 Mr. Ellis, who wrote and filed the habeas petition and who has
18 been representing [Petitioner] pro bono throughout the state post-
conviction proceedings and who is on the local CJA panel for
19 habeas cases, is willing to accept appointment in this case.

20 *Id.* Petitioner submitted a Declaration and Application to Proceed *In Forma Pauperis*, which
21 indicates he is indigent. *Id.* at p. 3. The Motion contains no other relevant information.

22 Petitioner is ordered to file additional briefing prior to the Court ruling on the Motion for
23 Appointment of Counsel. The additional briefing shall provide information regarding the scope

1 of Mr. Ellis's representation. Specifically, Petitioner shall provide information pertaining to the
2 commencement of the attorney-client relationship, the length of the relationship, and any other
3 pertinent information regarding the nature and scope of the services provided by Mr. Ellis.
4 Additionally, if Petitioner seeks appointment of a CJA panel attorney, he must submit a CJA 23
5 Financial Affidavit, which is available on the United States Courts website,
6 <http://www.uscourts.gov/>, under Forms & Services.

7 Petitioner must submit the additional briefing on or before August 27, 2015.
