**Continuing
Garnishee Order**

A Writ of Continuing Garnishment directed to Garnishee, Petco Corporate Office Headquarters HQ/Petco Animal Supplies Stores, Inc., has been duly issued and served upon the Garnishee. Pursuant to the Writ, Garnishee Petco Corporate Office Headquarters HQ/Petco Animal Supplies Stores, Inc., filed an Amended Answer on September 29, 2015, stating that at the time of the service of the Writ, Defendant/Judgment Debtor James K.

1 Kallam was an active employee, and that Garnishee was in possession of
2 earnings that were due and owed to Defendant/Judgment Debtor.

3 After notification of the garnishment proceeding was mailed to the
4 parties on or about July 27, 2015, the Defendant/Judgment Debtor has not
5 requested a hearing to determine exempt property as of this date.
6

7 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED as follows:

8 That the Garnishee, Petco Corporate Office Headquarters HQ/Petco
9 Animal Supplies Stores, Inc., shall pay to the United States District Court for
10 the Western District of Washington, the non-exempt earnings payable to
11 Defendant/Judgment Debtor James K. Kallam, upon each period of time
12 when Defendant/Judgment Debtor Kallam is entitled to receive such funds,
13 and shall continue said payments, if any, until Defendant/Judgment Debtor
14 Kallam's debt is paid in full or until Defendant/Judgment Debtor is no longer
15 an active employee of Garnishee and the Garnishee no longer has possession,
16 custody or control of any funds due and owing to the Defendant/Judgment
17 Debtor or until further order of this Court. This includes all monies
18 previously withheld by the Garnishee, in accordance with the Writ of
19 Continuing Garnishment;

22 That such payments shall be applied to Defendant/Judgment Debtor
23 Kallam's outstanding obligation, by the United States District Court for the
24 Western District of Washington; and


26 That the payments shall be made out to the United States District
