ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION  
TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS

The Court, having reviewed plaintiff's application to proceed *in forma pauperis*, does

hereby find and ORDER.

18 Plaintiff's declaration indicates that he is unable to afford the Court's filing fee or give  
19 security therefore. Accordingly, plaintiff's application to proceed *in forma pauperis* (Dkts. 1,4)  
20 is GRANTED. Plaintiff is not a prisoner within the meaning of the Prison Litigation Reform  
21 Act. The portion of the act requiring a prisoner to pay the filing fee in installments does not  
22 apply to plaintiff. Plaintiff does not appear to have funds available to afford the \$400.00 filing  
23 fee. Plaintiff shall note that leave to proceed as a pauper does not necessarily entitle plaintiff to a  
24 waiver of any other cost(s) of litigation.
