Accordingly, plaintiff's Motion to Proceed In Forma Pauperis (Dkt. 2) is 19 GRANTED. Plaintiff is not a prisoner within the meaning of the Prison Litigation Reform Act. 20 The portion of the act requiring a prisoner to pay the filing fee in installments does not apply to 21 plaintiff. Plaintiff does not appear to have funds available to afford the \$400.00 filing fee. 22 Plaintiff shall note that leave to proceed as a pauper does not necessarily entitle plaintiff to a 23 waiver of any other cost(s) of litigation.
