**ORDER GRANTING STIPULATED
MOTION FOR REMAND**

13 This Court has jurisdiction pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(c), Fed. R. Civ. P. 73 and Local
14 Magistrate Judge Rule MJR 13. *See also* Notice of Initial Assignment to a U.S. Magistrate
15 Judge and Consent Form, Dkt. 5; Consent to Proceed Before a United States Magistrate Judge,
16 Dkt. 6. This matter is before the Court on the parties' stipulated motion to remand the matter for
17 further administrative proceedings, Dkt. 19.

18 After reviewing the parties' stipulated motion and the relevant record, the Court
19 **GRANTS** the parties' motion and **ORDERS** that the case be **REVERSED** and **REMANDED**
20 for further administrative proceedings pursuant to sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g). On
21 remand, the Administrative Law Judge shall re-evaluate all of the evidence, including the
22 medical opinions, plaintiff's allegations about her limitations, and the lay evidence, and, if a
23 favorable decision is not made on the record, the ALJ will present a hypothetical to a vocational

1 expert that includes all of plaintiff's limitations. *See* Dkt. 19. The parties further stipulate that
2 plaintiff shall be eligible for attorneys' fees under the Equal Access to Justice Act, 24 U.S.C. §
3 2412 et seq., upon proper application to this Court. *Id.*
