or pace; reassess her residual functional capacity; reevaluate claimant's past work and determine 1 whether it meets the requirements of recency, income, and duration, in order to be considered 2 past relevant work (20 C.F.R. § 416.965(a)); if applicable, evaluate whether the claimant could 3 still perform past relevant work pursuant to 20 C.F.R. § 416.968 and Social Security Ruling 82-4 41; and determine whether she acquired skills from past relevant work that can be transferred to 5 other work in the national economy (20 C.F.R. §§ 416.966, 416.968), with little or no 6 adjustment; obtaining vocational expert testimony about the transferability of skills and any 7 vocational adjustment required, as necessary; obtaining other supplemental vocational evidence, 8 9 as necessary; and issue a new decision. Because the parties have stipulated that the case be remanded as set forth above, the 10 Court recommends that United States District Judge Benjamin H. Settle immediately approve 11 this Report and Recommendation. The Clerk should note the matter for **June 13, 2017** as ready 12 for Judge Settle's consideration.
