Dkts. 43, 44. In its previous order, the Court found "that RCW 29A.56.620 and 16 .640(6) constitute an unlawful (albeit minimal) restriction on Plaintiff's First Amendment 17 rights." Dkt. 43 at 13. Accordingly, the Court granted Plaintiff's motion for summary 18 judgment, denied Defendant's motion, and requested a joint status report to address 19 whether there remained any outstanding issues that must be resolved before the Court 20 enters a final order and directs the Clerk to enter a judgment. In light of the parties' joint 21 status report, the Court finds that there are no further outstanding matters before the 22

Court. Plaintiff has neither pled nor requested monetary damages, so none will be awarded. Therefore, it is hereby **ORDERED** that Defendant is permanently enjoined from enforcing RCW 29A.56.620 and .640(6) on minor party and independent candidates for President of the United States of America. The Clerk shall enter a JUDGMENT in favor of Plaintiff and close this case. Dated this 7th day of March, 2018. United States District Judge
