

1 Internal Revenue Service, not later than twenty (20) workdays following the entry of this
2 order to testify and produce records as demanded in such summonses.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the respondent fails to comply with this order,
5 the respondent can be held in contempt of Court and be subject to imprisonment, fine or
6 both.

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall send a copy of this
9 order by certified mail and first-class mail to the respondent, Lavonne M. Lal, 11312 NW
10 31st Avenue, Vancouver, Washington 98685-3569, to the United States Attorney, and to the
11 United States Magistrate Judge to whom this matter is assigned.
