
ORDER DENYING  
WITHDRAWAL OF COUNSEL

15 Before the court is Darryl Parker's motion to withdraw as counsel for Plaintiff Nsa  
16 Sam. (Mot. (Dkt. # 17).) Because the motion does not comply with the requirements for  
17 attorney withdrawal set forth in Local Civil Rule 83.2(b), the court DENIES the motion  
18 to withdraw without prejudice.

19 If withdrawal would leave a party unrepresented, the motion for withdrawal "must  
20 include the party's address and telephone number." Local Rules W.D. Wash. LCR  
21 83.2(b)(1). The instant motion fails to comply with this requirement, as Mr. Parker's  
22 withdrawal would leave Ms. Sam unrepresented, but the motion does not contain Ms.

1 Sam's telephone number. (*See generally* Mot.) The court therefore DENIES the motion  
2 to withdraw (Dkt. # 17) without prejudice to refileing the motion in the manner prescribed  
3 in Local Civil Rule 83.2(b).
