On September 21, 2017, the court ordered Plaintiff Sanaa Hammou to show cause why this action should not be dismissed for failure to serve Defendant with a summons copy of the complaint within the timeframe provided in Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4(m). (OSC (Dkt. # 9).) The court ordered Plaintiff to respond within ten days and warned Plaintiff that a failure to demonstrate good cause for the failure to comply with Rule 4(m) would result in dismissal of the action without prejudice. (*Id.* at 9.) More than ten days have passed since the court issued its order, and Plaintiff has failed to respond. (*See generally* Dkt.) Accordingly, the court DISMISSES Plaintiff's
