Currently pending in this action is plaintiff John Thomas Entler's 18 motion to exceed page limit. Dkt. 26. 19 Plaintiff requests that the Court allow him to file a reply 5 pages longer than allowed by 20 local rules. Though motions for overlength briefs are generally disfavored, the Court may 21 consider them if they are filed no later than three days before the brief is due, are no more than 22 two pages in length, and specify the amount of additional space requested. LCR 7(f). Plaintiff 23 24

1	has adhered to those requirements here. Further, he has filed his overlength reply (Dkt. 27) and
2	has adhered to the additional 5 pages he requested in his motion.
3	Therefore, it is ORDERED:
4	1) Plaintiff's motion to exceed page limit (Dkt. 26) is granted.
5	2) The Court will accept plaintiff's overlength reply (Dkt. 27).
6	3) The Court cautions that, because these motions are generally disfavored, the Court
7	will not look favorably on motions to exceed page limits in the future.
