**ORDER GRANTING EAJA FEES AND
COSTS**

14 The parties stipulate that Plaintiff should be awarded attorney fees of \$7,406.91 pursuant
15 to the Equal Access to Justice Act, § 2412(d), and costs in the amount of \$400 (filing fee)
16 pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1920, totaling \$7,806.91. Dkt. 20.

17 Accordingly, the Court **ORDERS** that attorney fees and costs in the total amount of
18 \$7,806.91 shall be paid to Plaintiff's attorney, subject to verification that Plaintiff does not have
19 a debt which qualifies for offset against the awarded fees, pursuant to the Treasury Offset
20 Program as discussed in *Astrue v. Ratliff*, 130 S.Ct. 2521 (2010).

21 If Plaintiff has no such debt, the check shall be made out to Plaintiff's attorney, Jamie
22 Evans: 610 SW Broadway, Suite 405, Portland, OR 97205. If Plaintiff has a debt, the check for
23 any remaining funds after offset of the debt shall be made out to Plaintiff and mailed to
Plaintiff's attorney's office at the address stated above.
