16 The following minute order is made by the direction of the court, the Honorable Marsha  
17 J. Pechman, United States Senior District Judge:

18 The Court has reviewed the Parties' Eleventh Quarterly Joint Status Report. (Dkt. No.  
19 149.) The Parties indicate that the Secretary of the Interior approved and signed the proposed  
20 Chinook Distribution Plan Package on September 11, 2023, and that it is now subject to a 60-day  
21 congressional review period. (Id. at 2.) The Court therefore ORDERS the Parties to submit an  
22 additional joint status report by no later than November 15, 2023 that: (1) provides an update on  
23 whether the plan has been subject to any congressional disapproval pursuant to 25 U.S.C. §  
24

1 1405; (2) indicates whether and on what terms the Court may dismiss this matter if the plan has  
2 become effective (i.e., there has been no congressional disapproval); and (3) addresses any other  
3 issues the Court should consider in resolving this matter.
