ORDER

15 This matter comes before the Court on the parties' stipulated motion for attorney fees
16 under the Equal Access to Justice Act ("EAJA"), 28 U.S.C. § 2412 (Dkt. No. 16). Plaintiff was
17 the prevailing party on an appeal of an agency action and is thus entitled to an award of attorney
18 fees. (See Dkt. Nos. 13–15.) Finding the requested award reasonable and just, the Court
19 GRANTS Plaintiff's motion. Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2412(d), the Court AWARDS attorney fees
20 in the amount of \$6,198.88.

21 If the Department of the Treasury determines that Plaintiff's EAJA fees are not subject to
22 any offset allowed under the Department's Offset Program, then the check for attorney fees shall
23 be made payable to Plaintiff's attorney, David Oliver, based upon Plaintiff's assignment of these
24 amounts to counsel. The check shall be mailed to Plaintiff's counsel at the following address:
