16	The District Court referred this 42 U.S.C. § 1983 action to United States Magistrate		
17	Judge David W. Christel. Plaintiff James A. Williams, proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis,		
18	initiated this civil rights action in December of 2017. See Dkt. 1.		
19	After reviewing Plaintiff's complaint, the Court ordered Plaintiff to show cause or file an		
20	amended complaint on or before April 20, 2018. Dkt. 11. Plaintiff failed to do so, and on May 9,		
21	2018, the undersigned entered a Report and Recommendation ("R&R") recommending		
22	Plaintiff's case be dismissed for failure to obey a court order. Dkt. 12. On May 15, 2018,		
23	Plaintiff filed a letter with the Clerk that the Court interprets as a Motion for Extension of Time,		
24	stating he had lost most of his legal materials, inclu	ding cause numbers, and requesting new	

1	copies as	well as blank civil rights forms to the amended complaints. Dkt. 15. In fight of this, it
2	appears Pl	aintiff does intend to pursue his case.
3	Th	erefore, it is ORDERED:
4	1)	The Court's R&R recommending dismissal (Dkt. 12) is vacated.
5	2)	Plaintiff's Motion for Extension of Time (Dkt. 13) is granted.
6	3)	Plaintiff may file his Amended Complaint on or before June 22, 2018.
7	4)	Plaintiff is reminded that failure to file an Amended Complaint by that date will result
8		in the Court once again recommending his case be dismissed.
