1 under the Treasury Offset Program, and (3) agrees to waive the requirements of the 2 Anti-Assignment Act, then the EAJA fees will be made payable to Plaintiff's attorney. 3 However, if there is a debt owed under the Treasury Offset Program, the Commissioner 4 cannot agree to waive the requirements of the Anti-Assignment Act, and the remaining 5 EAJA fees after offset will be paid by a check made out to Plaintiff but delivered to 6 Plaintiff's attorney. 7 2.
