ORDER TO FILE NEW
APPLICATION TO PROCEED IN
FORMA PAUPERIS

16 Plaintiff DeWaun James Swan, proceeding *pro se*, filed this civil rights complaint under
17 42 U.S.C. § 1983. While in custody at the Pierce County Jail, he also filed a Motion for Leave to
18 Proceed *In Forma Pauperis* (“Motion for IFP”). Dkt. 4. However, Plaintiff has now notified the
19 Court of a change of address (*see* dkt. event at 5/29/2018) and, on May 31, 2018, he visited the
20 Clerk’s office, indicating he is no longer in custody at the Pierce County Jail. The Court requires
21 a different application when a non-prisoner is applying to proceed *in forma pauperis*. Because of
22 Plaintiff’s change of circumstance, it is ORDERED:

- 23 1) Plaintiff shall file an updated Motion for IFP on or before July 6, 2018.
24 2) In the alternative, Plaintiff may pay the \$400.00 filing fee.

1 3) The Clerk is directed to provide Plaintiff with the forms necessary for a non-prisoner
2 to apply to proceed *in forma pauperis*.
