Based on General Orders No. 01-20 and No. 02-20, the Court determines that trial in
this case cannot proceed on the currently scheduled date of May 19, 2020. General Order No.
02-20 provides that all civil and criminal hearings and trial dates in the Seattle and Tacoma
Courthouses scheduled to occur before June 1, 2020 are continued pending further order of
the Court. The need to protect the public health and safety of all those entering and working
in the Courthouse as detailed in General Order No. 02-20 constitutes good cause to modify
the scheduling order pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 16(b)(4).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the trial date and other dates shall be continued.
 The trial date of May 19, 2020, and all other upcoming dates in this case, are hereby
 VACATED.

The parties shall file a Joint Status Report on or before June 1, 2020, with an agreed

proposed schedule for a trial date and all pretrial deadlines. If the parties do not agree on a
 proposed schedule, each side shall set forth, in a single report, separate proposals for the trial
 date and pretrial deadlines.

If the parties believe that the pretrial conference or other anticipated hearings may be effectively conducted by video/teleconference, they may identify those hearings in the Joint Status report.
