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17 Pursuant to the parties' stipulated motion, the Court hereby ORDERS that this matter is
18 remanded to the Commissioner under 42 U.S.C. § 405(g) (fourth sentence), for further
19 administrative proceedings. On remand, the administrative law judge will reevaluate the medical
20 opinion evidence, including the prior administrative medical findings from the State agency
21 psychological consultants; reevaluate the residual functional capacity; continue with the
22 sequential evaluation process, to include obtaining vocational expert testimony, as necessary;
23 and offer the claimant the opportunity for a hearing, take further action to complete the
24 administrative record resolving the above issue, and issue a new decision.

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
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1 After judgment, Plaintiff may be entitled to reasonable attorney's fees and costs pursuant
