ORDER

Based on the parties' agreement and stipulation, and good cause shown, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

1. Pursuant to sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g), the above-captioned case is reverse d and remanded to the Defendant Commissioner of Social Security for further administrative proceedings and a new decision with respect to Plaintiff Jennifer Lawson's applications for Supplemental Security Income under Title XVI of the Social Security Act, respectively.
2. On remand, the administrative law judge (ALJ) shall:
 - a. Reassess the medical opinions and prior administrative medical finding, including the opinion of William R. Wilkinson, EdD;

1 b. As necessary, reassess the claimant's residual functional capacity, the step-four
2 finding, and step-five finding; and

3 c. Offer the claimant the opportunity for a hearing, take further action to complete the
4 administrative record resolving the above issues, and issue a new decision.

5 3. Plaintiff shall be entitled to move for reasonable attorney fees and costs, pursuant to
6 28 U.S.C. § 2412(d).
