Leave to amend is limited to Plaintiff's First Amendment retaliation 21 claims against Defendants Boylan and Miller. If Plaintiff wishes to proceed in this 22 action, he must file a second amended complaint no later than 30 days from the 23 date of this Order. Failure to file a second amended complaint by the stated 24

1	deadline will result in dismissal of this action for failure to comply with a court
2	order and for failure to state a claim.
3	(4) The Clerk is directed to send copies of this Order to Plaintiff, counsel for the
4	Defendants, and to the Hon. David W. Christel.
