MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER

By Standing Order, this matter was referred to United States Magistrate Judge Omar J. Aboulhosn for submission of proposed findings and recommendations ("PF&R") for disposition pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B). See Doc. No. 7.

Magistrate Judge Aboulhosn submitted to the court his PF&R on April 10, 2017, in which he recommended that the court grant Defendants Stock, Rife, and Lucas' "Motion to Dismiss, or in the Alternative, Motion for Summary Judgment," <u>see</u> Doc. No. 26; dismiss Plaintiff's Complaint, <u>see</u> Doc. No. 3, with prejudice as to Defendants Stock, Rife, and Lucas; dismiss Plaintiff's Complaint, <u>see</u> Doc. No. 3, without prejudice as to Defendants Martinez and Mouse; and remove this matter from the court's docket.

In accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 636(b), the parties were allotted seventeen days in which to file any objections to the

Magistrate Judge's PF&R. The failure of any party to file such objections within the time allotted constitutes a waiver of such party's right to a <u>de novo</u> review by this court. <u>See Snyder v.</u> <u>Ridenour</u>, 889 F.2d 1363 (4th Cir. 1989). Neither party filed any objections to the Magistrate Judge's PF&R within the required time period.

Accordingly, the court adopts Magistrate Judge Aboulhosn's PF&R as follows:

- 1)Defendants Stock, Rife, and Lucas' "Motion to Dismiss, or in the Alternative, Motion for Summary Judgment," see Doc. No. 26, is GRANTED;
- 2) Plaintiff's Complaint, <u>see</u> Doc. No. 3, is **DISMISSED** with prejudice as to Defendants Stock, Rife, and Lucas;
- 3) Plaintiff's Complaint, <u>see</u> Doc. No. 3, is **DISMISSED** without prejudice as to Defendants Martinez and Mouse; and
- The Clerk is directed to remove this matter from the docket of the court.

The Clerk is further directed to forward a copy of this Memorandum Opinion and Order to counsel of record and to Plaintiff.
