MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER

On March 12, 2010, this court entered a Memorandum Opinion and Order [2:09-mc-214, Docket 3] in Case No. 2:09-mc-214, granting defendant Wilshire Credit Corporation's Motion to Withdraw Reference of this Adversary Proceeding.
