MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER

This action was referred to the Honorable Dwane L. Tinsley, United States Magistrate Judge, for submission to this Court of proposed findings of fact and recommendation for disposition, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B). The Magistrate Judge has submitted findings of fact and recommended that the Court grant Claimant's request to reverse the Commissioner's decision (ECF No. 14), deny the Commissioner's request to affirm his decision (ECF No. 15), reverse the final decision of the Commissioner, and remand this case to Commissioner for further proceedings.
