MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER

This action was referred to the Honorable Dwane L. Tinsley, United States Magistrate Judge, for submission to this Court of proposed findings of fact and recommendation for disposition, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B). The Magistrate Judge has submitted findings of fact and recommended that the Court deny Claimant's request to reverse the Commissioner's decision (ECF No. 16), grant the Commissioner's request to affirm his decision (ECF No. 17), affirm the final decision of the Commissioner, and dismiss this action from the Court's docket. Neither party has filed objections to the Magistrate Judge's findings and recommendation.

Accordingly, the Court accepts and incorporates herein the findings and recommendations of the Magistrate Judge and **DENIES** Claimant's request to reverse the Commissioner's decision (ECF No. 16), **GRANTS** the Commissioner's request to affirm his decision (ECF No. 17), **AFFIRMS** the final decision of the Commissioner, and **DISMISSES** this action from the Court's docket, consistent with the findings and recommendation.
