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**STIPULATION OF COUNSEL REGARDING  
STATE OF WISCONSIN'S MOTION TO INTERVENE**

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Plaintiff S.V. by her attorneys Fox & Fox S.C., by Michael R. Fox and defendant Kenneth Kratz by his attorneys Hammett, Bellin & Oswald, LLC, by Robert E. Bellin, Jr., and the State of Wisconsin, proposed Intervenor, by Attorney General J.B. Van Hollen by Assistant Attorneys General Monica Burkert-Brist and Carrie Benedon, stipulate as follows:

1. The parties stipulate that the State of Wisconsin's motion to intervene for the sole purpose of litigating the issue of potential indemnification of the defendant by the State shall be granted;
2. The State stipulates that, at this stage of the proceedings, as noted in its Motion to Intervene and supporting materials, the State wishes to be heard only on the scope of employment/indemnity issue and not on the merits or factual disputes in this case, except as may be necessary to argue the indemnity issue.

3. Therefore, the State stipulates that it does not, and will not seek to appear on any issue which may be raised by defendant as to the sufficiency of the complaint filed by the plaintiff in this case.
